Subject: National camp for Central & South Asia 7s, 2026 for Senior Women

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the Indian National Senior Women's Rugby Team will be participating in the Central & South Asia 7s, 2026, scheduled to be held from 16th to 17th May 2026 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan. In preparation for this competition, a National Coaching Camp will be conducted at the SAI Netaji Subhas Eastern Centre, Kolkata, West Bengal, from 1st to 14th May 2026.

This competition provides a much needed opportunity to strengthen and expand the national player pool, with predominantly lower-ranked teams participating and the only higher-ranked team i.e. Kazakhstan, set to field its development squad. In lieu of the same and keeping in mind the long season ahead for the women's team, players who represented India at the ARSS 2025 will be rested for this tourney. The camp will comprise athletes from the Top 16 group of 2025 who did not participate in ARSS 2025, along with players identified from the Senior National 7s Championship 2026 held in Rajgir, Bihar (16th–17th April 2026). 
Players rested for this competition will be eligible to be called to the camps for Asia Rugby Sevens Series & Asian Games scheduled to start from July 2026.

All selected players will be required to attend the camp for its full duration. The High-Performance Team will coordinate directly with the selected athletes regarding reporting details, logistics, and other requirements. Following the camp, the final selected squad will travel to represent India at the Central & South Asia 7s, 2026. All expenses for the camp and international participation will be borne by the Indian Rugby Football Union.
