We are pleased to inform you that the Indian National U20 Rugby Teams will be participating in the Asia Rugby U20 Championship scheduled to be held in Bihar, India from the 09 - 10 August, 2025. In order to prepare our team for this prestigious event, a National Camp will be held in SAI Netaji Subhas Eastern Centre, Kolkata, West Bengal from 03 July -06 August, 2025

All players are required to report to camp on 03 July, 2025 no later than 4pm.
