Position Summary:

The Head Coach of the Indian National Men's Rugby Sevens Team will play a critical role in strengthening India's presence on the international rugby sevens stage. The position is responsible for providing strategic, technical, and operational leadership for the national men's team during the upcoming season, with the competition calendar outlined in *Annexure I*.

In addition to overseeing elite performance, the Head Coach will contribute to the long-term development of Sevens rugby in India by raising performance standards and supporting the growth of the domestic high-performance pathway.
