Section 9 of FC ® Act, 1976, provides inter alia that no member of a legislature, office bearer of a political party, judge, Government servant or employee of any corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without the prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above act, he/ she obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before their departure to Taiwan, Chinese Taipei.
- As regards foreign exchange required for above participation, the federation is requested to approach authorized dealers for getting the foreign exchange in view of RBI circular No. 41 A.D (M.A. Series) dated 25.1.97.
- 3. Such of the team member who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (Which include deputation abroad) in respect of the participation by

the Departure / Office in which they are employed in teams of Department Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Est. (Pay-1) dated 30.1.1989. The federation should inform their employing Department/ Office accordingly.

- 4. It is requested that Indian High Commission/ Embassy in Taiwan, Chinese Taipei and organizers of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
- 5. A report on the visit of the team along with its performance / achievement in the above Event may please be sent to SP IV/TEAMS Division, SAI within 7 days of the return of the team to India along with some action photographs, if possible.
- Before departure, a report on dope test of the team members may be obtained from DG, NADA New Delhi.

I am also directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority for the payment of:-

- Participation of Indian Under 18 Boys' and Girls' Rugby Sevens Teams participating in the Asia Rugby U18 Rugby Sevens to be held at Taiwan, Chinese Taipei on the 30th September to 1st October, 2023 with an estimated expenditure of Rs. 53,82,400/-(Rupees Fifty-three lakh eighty-two thousand four hundred only)
- A sum of Rs 3,61,050/- (Rupees Three lakh sixty-one thousand fifty only) towards 75% of the total estimated cost of advance Rs. 4,81,400/- (Rupees Four lakh eighty-one thousand four hundred only) (excluding Airfare, OPA, Visa) to Indian Rugby Football Union for making smooth arrangements.
- 3. Out of Pocket Allowance i.e. Rs. 2,82,200/- @ Rs. 8,300/- per person for 34 members for 04 days to be transferred towards participating in the Asia Rugby U18 Rugby Sevens to be held at Taiwan, Chinese Taipei on the 30th September to 1st October, 2023 directly in their bank account.
- 4. The settlement will be done on receipt of expenditure details along with bills/vouchers/invoice submitted by Indian Rugby Football Union within 15 days after the event is over to Sports Authority of India.
- The amount sanctioned herein will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer, Sports Authority of India on the prescribed bill immediately for disbursing the same to grantee through Electronic Clearing System. This grant is of non-recurring nature.

The grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below:-

- i. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organizations and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will be required to refund the entire amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum.
- ii. The Expenditure statement along with bills/vouchers duly verified should be submitted within 07 days along with the performance-cum-achievement report in respect of the above event for which the grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to the SP-IV, MYAS/TEAMS DIVISION, Sports Authority of India with a copy to Government Observer within one week of the completion of event.
- iii. That some photographs of the events, i.e. events, medal winners etc. with sample invitation cards for opening and closing ceremony and copies of newspaper clippings related to the event preferably in National and Regional dailies be sent to this office along with performance-cum-achievement report.
- iv. That the amount in INR will be subject to the actual rate of Foreign Exchange on the date of payment by the Federation. The difference, if any, in INR will be adjusted.
- There is no reason to believe that the grantee is involved in corrupt practice.
- vi. That no advertisement of Tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of grant.
- vii. Amount of grant should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance of grant shall be refunded **Indian Rugby Football Union** immediately after conclusion of the event.
- viii. The grant is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.

- ix. The fact the program is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Sports Authority of India should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programs/events etc.
- x. When the Sports Authority of India/Government of India/State Government has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant will be stopped. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause IV above.
- xi. The grantee institution or organization should exercise reasonable economy in the working of the approved projects.
- xii. As per GFR-212(1), the accounts of grantee institution or organization shall be opened to inspection by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports/Sports Authority of India and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit of Sports Authority of India, New Delhi, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.
- 5. The above sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Director General/Secretary/Executive Director of Sports Authority of India. It is certified that the grant being released is in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- 6. The amount of grant will be debitable to the Major Head 49.0500 (Assistance to National Sports Federations) for the Financial Year 2023-24 to Indian Rugby Football Union
